PrEP the Future is a free, virtual Youth-HIV leadership bootcamp run by LetsStopAIDS. Candidates selected across the entire globe will have the opportunity to enhance their organizational and advocacy skills while raising awareness on HIV prevention.

Youth HIV Leadership & HIV Response

Why Youth HIV Leadership?

The HIV response and youth leadership are intimately connected. Young people are disproportionately affected by HIV, with over **2 million new infections** annually. However, they are also powerful agents of change, capable of driving progress toward ending the epidemic. By fostering youth leadership and advocacy, we can **empower young people** to take ownership of the HIV response, from designing and implementing prevention programs to advocating for policy change.





Overview

What will you learn?

- Learners will cover organization and recruitment skills
- Learners will have the opportunity to meet with trainers, and receive mentorship
- Learners will gain experience with public speaking, and shaping their personal narratives to motivate action.
- Learners will have the opportunity to network with young leaders from all over the world

What will you receive?

The selected 40 participants will receive a grant of 250£, plus a certificate of completion at the end of the course.

Participants will have the opportunity to work on their plans as well as receive feedback and support from their peers to refine their plan based on key learnings.

Top three projects will be given an opportunity to showcase their campaign at the 2023 NoTimeToWait conference hosted by LetsStopAIDS.



Overview

9 weeks | 40 global participants

Dates

July 1st - August 31st 2023

Throughout the 9 weeks, there will be 12 modules. Each module will be covered across the 12 sessions.

Expected time commitment is 2-3 hours per week.

Format

Live Online Classrooms

Learners will need regular computer and internet access to participate in live sessions.

Our Aim

- Incorporate a youth perspective in the global HIV response.
- Provide tools and resources for young people to advocate for efficient HIV prevention.

Program Methodology

Training Sessions

40 participants will create and implement HIV awareness campaigns within their communities

Mentoring

Different lived experiences during implementation will help us to validate the toolkit to support diverse youth-led awareness campaigns

Project Implementation

At the end, participants will co-create a manifesto with the concerns of youth to be delivered to international organizations

Networking & Final Seminar
